

How to Make Scholarship Selection Committee Love You

Before you submit your scholarship application, check out these tips provided by scholarship selection committee members:

- Apply only if you are eligible:
 - The USAWOA Scholarship Foundation Vocational School – Technical College scholarship is open to students taking any field of study offered at these schools.
 - Vocational School – Technical College fields of study are typically 2-year certification programs. Therefore, you may apply for another USAWOA Scholarship Foundation Vocational – Technical College scholarship for your 2nd year of study.
 - A maximum of 2 USAWOA Foundation Vocational School - Technical College are authorized per student.
 - Only 1 USAWOA Scholarship Foundation scholarship per school year is authorized.
- Complete the application in full. If a question does not apply, note that on the application checklist. Do not leave any question blank. Provide all additional support documents, such as transcripts, letters of recommendations and your essay.
- **Attention to detail:** provide all information that is required.
- Type your application (**ARIAL font 12**) **double spaced**.
- Essay needs to be **strong and enthusiastic**. The Selection committee wants you to make a strong impression about you and your essay.
- Set a deadline to keep yourself on track. There are no extensions!

- **Mail your application packet to the address on USAWOASF VT Form 2026-1.** Put your name on every page in case it gets separated.
