- (b) Imagine yourself 10 years from now as the person you hope to become. Looking back, what would you want this scholarship committee to know about why they made the right decision selecting you?
- (c) If you could design or create something new (a tool, system, or idea) that would improve people's lives, what would it be and why?

Exceptional circumstances – Detailed letter outlining any factor(s) that would impact you attending college.

Extracurricular activities – Detailed list of extracurricular activities you have been involved in and address them.

Three (3) Letters of Recommendation.

High School and College (if applicable) transcripts showing grades and grade point average.

National Test Scores (SAT and/or ACT)

- If there are no scores to submit, a letter of justification must be submitted with your packet.

A 4 X 6 head and shoulder high resolution 4 X 6 photo on glossy paper and portrait mode of you only.
